Digital transformation

- Digitalisation and Industry 4.0.
- Support on government level to digitalisation of industries.

The process of digital transformation in Estonia

- Government digitalisation started in the '90s, and by the year 2000, the first digital service was introduced to citizens (e-tax declaration, e-Residency).

Ministry of Social Affairs

- Develops policies on safe working environment.
- Supervision by Labour Inspectorate.
- Awareness raising in cooperation with Labour Inspectorate: workplace exposure to carcinogens 2018-2019.

Risk management and digital transformation

- OSH web-based tools and information channels.
- OSH documents through client portal of the Labour Inspectorate.
- Tööelu portaal – the Working life portal (www.tooelu.ee) contains latest OSH information.

Risk management and digital transformation

Tööbik:

- web-based interactive tool for OSH risk assessment – to help employers to comply with the legal requirements (developed by the Ministry of Social Affairs in cooperation with Labour Inspectorate in 2014).

Risk management and digital transformation

Working Life Information System:

- smart information system that is connected to other state registries;
- helps employer to create a safe working environment;
- helps Labour Inspectorate to communicate with companies more effectively;
- allows doctors to obtain information about the OSH situation in a company (hazards, risk factors).
